The file with materials should be named using the surname of the first author and the section number, for example: Tkachenko_materials_5.doc (or .docx), Tkachenko_application_5.doc (or .docx).

REQUIREMENTS FOR MATERIALS

Articles are accepted for publication in Ukrainian or English within the topics of the conference. Materials must not have been previously published and should contain new theoretical and practical results. Formatting requirements: *paper size* A4; *file format* Microsoft Word (*.doc, *.docx); *margins* left, right, top, bottom - 2 cm; *font name* Times New Roman; *font size* 14; *line spacing* single (1.0); *paragraph indent* 1.25 cm; *volume* up to 3 pages; *minimum text originality* 30%.

STRUCTURE OF MATERIALS

- **UDC Index** – aligned to the left;
- **Title of the article** – in capital letters, bold font, center-aligned;
- **Author's (authors') full name(s)** – in lowercase letters, bold font, center-aligned;
- **Academic degree and academic title** – center-aligned;
- **Place of work** – written in the nominative case, center-aligned;
- **Main text** – begins one line below, formatted as follows: (font size 14, line spacing – 1,0, paragraph indent – 1,25 cm, text aligning - justified);

At the end of the article, provide a **List of References** arranged in the order of citation in the text under the heading "References".

In-text **citations** are marked with square brackets containing the source number, for example: [5].

Any *graphical materials* (drawings, diagrams, charts, figures) should be labeled as: "**Fig. 1. Title of the figure**", and numbered using Arabic numerals. The caption is placed below the figure, center-aligned, and written in bold italic font.

Each figure must be separated from the text above and below by one blank line, and there must be a reference to each figure in the text (e.g., Fig. 1).

Tables are labeled with the word "Table 1" and numbered using Arabic numerals. The label and table number are right-aligned, while the table title is placed on the next line, center-aligned, and written in bold font. Font size in tables and figures should be no smaller than 12 pt. Each table must be separated from the text above and below by one blank line, and all tables must be referenced in the text (e.g., Table 1).
